

AP English Language 12 Enrollment Policy

Transfer Students to Castle High School must meet all 3 of the following criteria in order to take AP English Language and Composition.

- 1. Summer Assignment** – All students who take this course must complete a summer assignment and submit it online by August 1st. Any student who enrolls during the summer or just prior to the start of school will be expected to complete the assignment. A three week time frame from the time of enrollment will be given in order to complete this assignment. They can find information about the assignment at: <http://www.castlehs.com/users/fbracher/>
- 2. Course Articulation/GPA** – Students who enroll in AP English Language 12 should have been enrolled in Advanced English at their previous school and maintained a “B” average in these courses. Any grade lower than a “B” is not acceptable. Students should also have at least a 3.0 overall GPA in order to take this course
- 3. This course offers Dual Credit from Ivy Tech/USI for English. Below are the expectations from the University of Southern Indiana and Ivy Tech. These requirements must be met by any student who plans to enroll in the class. Students who do not meet these requirements are not permitted to take the course.**

English 101/111/112 students must meet two of the following three criteria:

- Rank at or above the 51st percentile in the high school class (For example, multiply the number of students in the class by .49 [100 x .49 = 49] which gives you the minimum required rank to qualify for English 101.)
- SAT Critical Reading score of 450 or greater; PSAT Critical Reading (juniors) of 45 or greater (or ACT Reading score of 19 or greater).
- SAT Writing score of 450 or greater; PSAT Writing (juniors) of 45 or greater (or ACT Combined English/Writing score of 19 or greater)
