

FILM LITERATURE STUDENT CONTRACT

As seniors you are young adults. Adults accept the responsibility of the consequences of the choices they make daily. Therefore, it is best to know the rules and the regulations of the class so you can make wise decisions.

I. CLASS ASSIGNMENTS

1. All class assignments must be submitted during the period on the assigned due date.
2. A half-letter grade deduction will be assessed for work submitted late during the school day.
3. A letter grade deduction will be assessed for each school day an assignment is late.
4. Only 8 ½ X 11 loose leaf paper should be used for notes, assignments and tests. Spiral bound paper should not be used.
5. Every student must have a notebook, folder, and a pen or pencil for each class daily.
6. The format and requirements of each assignment will be explained in class.
7. All make-up work with excused absences must be completed within TWO days. One additional day is added for multiple absences. Each student is responsible for arranging a time to make up work that is missed. Any student who does not make up work within the allotted time will forfeit the right to complete the work. A student who signs up but does not show will also forfeit the right to complete the work.
8. Students must make up work on their own time. Tests, videos, worksheets and notes may be made up during supervised study or before and after school.
9. Each student is responsible for finding out what work has been missed when absent. Be sure to check the assignment board or ask a fellow student to find out if notes were taken, if videos were watched, or if any handouts were given to the entire class.
10. Tests and assignments cannot be made up with unexcused absences.
11. Extra credit work will be offered ONLY to the entire class.
12. Students caught cheating on tests or assignments will be given an automatic "ZERO."
13. Sleeping during the class will NOT be tolerated. All students are expected to stay awake and pay attention during class.
14. Students must follow ALL directions.
15. The rules and regulations may be expanded or changed to meet the needs of the class

II. CLASS CONDUCT

1. Each student must be in his or her seat and ready to work when the tone sounds.
2. The teacher, not the tone, will dismiss the class.
3. Each student must have a pen or pencil, paper, and notebook at class daily. The text will be used for a few assignments and students will be notified when to bring the text to class.
4. NO FOOD or DRINKS will be allowed in class.
5. Courtesy and respect for the teacher and fellow students is demanded.
6. Demerits will be issued for the following infractions:
 - A. coming to class without proper materials
 - B. being tardy to class
 - C. texting with cell phone
 - D. acting or speaking in an unacceptable manner
 - E. habitually borrowing materials
 - F. sleeping during class
7. Use the restroom during passing periods instead of during class.
8. NO SLEEPING
