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I. Grade Scale (percent)

II. Point Accumulation

A. Homework

1. Homework will be picked up at random during each 9 weeks.
2. Homework will be graded with the **emphasis on having the assignment completed and the proper work shown.**

B. Quizzes

1. 1 to 5 quizzes will be given each week.
2. These quizzes will not be announced ahead of time. **(be prepared for a quiz each day)**
3. Quizzes will be worth 5 to 20 points.

C. Test

1. There will be 3 to 4 test each nine weeks.
2. Test will be announced one week ahead of time. **(students should be able to approximate test day by using the assignment guide)**
3. The point value of each test will be determined by the amount of material and importance of the material covered.

D. Final

1. There will be a final each semester over the material covered that semester.
3. The final will be approximately 100 pts.

E. Make-up

1. **All missed work that is graded will be made up in a reasonable amount of time.**

III. Nine Weeks Grades

A. Grade Report Forms will be sent home with the student approximately every 3 Weeks.

B. Nine weeks grades will be based on a total accumulation of points from homework, quizzes, and test.

C. Sample Nine week grade: Home work -20 assignments - 84 out of 100

Quizzes -12 quizzes - 81 out of 100

Test - 3 test -223 out of 300

Total - 388 out of 500-78%-grade C+(Rounded to the nearest percent)

IV. Semester Grades

A. Your Semester grade is an accumulation of your nine weeks point totals.

B. Your semester grade is the only grade that goes on your permanent record.

C. Sample semester grade: 1st nine weeks -388 out of 500-78%-C+ (Rounded to the nearest percent)

2nd nine weeks -445 out of 500-89%-B+ (Rounded to the nearest percent)

Total -833 out of 1000-83%-B- (Rounded to the nearest percent)
